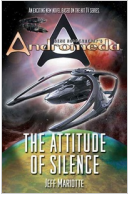
Intensity

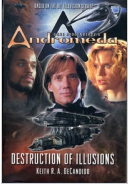

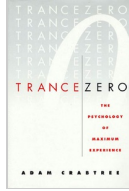
